Ke Kula Kaiapuni 'o Ānuenue is a K-12 Hawaiian Language Immersion Program school located in Pālolo. Hawaiian is the language of instruction in all classes except for our English Language Arts (grades 5-12) periods. Our 3 major foci are

- High proficiency in the Hawaiian language
- Learning and living the traditional Hawaiian cultural values and skills, and
- Rigorous academic achievement in Math, Science, and Language Arts.

We have over 400 students who come to our campus from all parts of the island. We provide chartered bus transportation from the leeward coast, Pearl City, Kalihi, and Kane'ohe.

Our extra-curricular activities include major Hawaiian cultural events as well as regular D.O.E. activities such as OIA sports, proms, and school assemblies.

Admission to our school is done via the DOE Geographic Exception process. Students entering grades K-2 need not come with a strong Hawaiian language background, but those seeking to enter at all higher grades should have grade level proficiency in Hawaiian.
