Calculating the Score

Raw Score: The raw value of the measure.

Step 1: Calculate Points: The points earned within this measure.

Step 2: Weight Points: The weight of the points within the Academic Performance Framework.

Step 3: Overall Score. The product of the weight of the measure applied to the points earned in the measure. These points, summed with the points earned from the other measures, equal the Overall Score.

High-Needs Students

The "High-Needs" student group includes all students with Disadvantaged, Special Education, or English Language Learner status. Measure 2a compares the proficiency of a school's High-Needs students against statewide average proficiency rates of all High-Needs students. Measure 2b evaluates the growth of the school's High-Needs students.
