Responsibilities for Secondary English Language Arts Teacher

- A. Instructs student citizenship and basic subject matter.
- B. Develops lesson plans and instructional materials and provides individualized and small group instruction in order to adapt the curriculum to the needs of each student.
- C. Uses a variety of instructional strategies, such as inquiry, group discussion, lecture, project-based learning, ect.
- D. Translates lesson plans into learning experiences so as to best utilize the available time for instruction.
- E. Establishes and maintains standards of student behavior needed to achieve a functional learning atmosphere in the classroom.
- F. Evaluates students' academic and social growth, keeps accurate, appropriate records, and prepares progress reports and report cards.
- G. Communicates with parents through conferences and other means to discuss students' progress and interpret the school program.
- H. Identifies student needs and cooperates with other professional staff members in assessing and helping students solve health, attitude and learning problems.
- I. Maintains professional competence through in-service education activities provided by professional growth activities.
- J. Participates cooperatively with the director to develop the method by which the teacher will be evaluated in conformance with guidelines.
- K. Supervises students in out-of-classroom activities during the school day and while on excursions.
- L. Administers group and individual standardized test in accordance with the state testing program.
- M. Participates in curriculum development and computer-based programs as required.
- N. Participates in faculty committees and the sponsorship of student activities and school events.
